BID stands for 'Business Improvement District': a not-for-profit, non-political organisation, elected by city centre businesses within the defined Bristol BID boundary. These businesses pay a levy that is used to develop high-impact projects for the benefit of our business community.

Through these projects, Bristol BID helps shape a safer, greener, cleaner and more vibrant city centre. We are a

powerful collective voice, representing businesses on transport, planning and licensing applications, interpreting policy and informing its development, whilst ensuring you have a voice through our response to city-wide consultations
